VILLAGE MAIN DEPOT AND CARPORT

1. OBJECTIVE(S)

The main objective of this RFQ is to appoint a qualified and experienced service provider to carry out comprehensive building condition and structural integrity assessment of the depots indicated below and to provide professional advice to enable Metrobus to implement the appropriate intervention actions. The service provider shall comply with all relevant government legislation as well as comply with **Metrobus** terms and conditions.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

Under the overall guidance and supervision of the Metrobus appointed Project Manager, the service provider shall provide its expertise as required to manage, coordinate and execute all the required services related to the building condition and integrity assessment. The service provider shall adopt a professional approach when undertaking the integrity assessment and in accordance with any local and international standards, and shall be deemed to have conducted a comprehensive investigation based on the existing records, site inspections and tests. The integrity assessment should cover the following areas:

- Structural & Foundation systems – exposed systems only;
- Roofing – types, age, and condition;
- Exterior enclosure – masonry, pre-cast, curtain wall, EIFS, glazing etc;
- Interior systems – walls, partitions, doors, ceilings, flooring, finishes, etc;
- Plumbing systems – existing;
- Electrical systems – existing;
- Fire equipment & accessibility compliance updates;
- Site components – parking lots, walkways, curbs, lighting, and site drainage;
- Security, overall safety and accessibility of the site
- Compiling bill of quantities based on the condition assessment of the property,
- Recommended actions for identified defects, including cost estimates.
