MBD 9: CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION

1. This Form "I" must form part of all bids¹ invited.
2. Section 4 (1) (b) (iii) of the Competition Act No. 89 of 1998, as amended, prohibits an agreement between, or concerted practice by, firms, or a decision by an association of firms, if it is between parties in a horizontal relationship and if it involves collusive bidding (or bid rigging).² Collusive bidding is a *pe se* prohibition meaning that it cannot be justified under any grounds.

Additional requirements:

- (i) Cost containment regulations must be taken in to account.
- (ii) Direct flights are preferred. The TMC must provide cost implications of direct vs connecting flights. Connecting flights should have minimum stop over time, at least 2hours maximum, to allow for clearance and boarding time between flights.

The entity requires the TMC to provide an alternative costing when the officials fly premium economy vs economy. This is to determine if there will be significant savings if this approach is followed.

Accommodation costs

It is preferred that the accommodation closer to the venue where the event is taking place. Please refer to preferred accommodation as included above by the ITB trade exhibition organisers, should it not be available, then the accommodation must be sought within 200m walking distance from the venue to avoid additional transport costs.
